### **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

- 01) The Home Table Tennis Tournament is for the Members/Associates, their spouse & children (7 yrs +).
- 02) Entry Forms are available at Main Reception.
- 03) The Entries will be closed on **Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2025 at 10:00 p.m.** and the draws will be displayed on the Table-Tennis Court Notice Board on the **Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2025 after 07:00 p.m.**
- 04) The Entrance Fee shall be Rs.125/- per participant per event for each Singles & Rs.100/- per participant for the Doubles Events (Rs.200/- per Pair per Event) inclusive of taxes
- 05) Separate Forms for Singles & Doubles Events need to be filled. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
- 06) ENTRIES will not be accepted without applicable Entry Fees.
- 07) All Quarter Finals, Semi Finals & Finals of Men, Semi Finals & Finals of Women / Youth Boys & Girls – Singles Event shall be Best of 07 Games. All other matches shall be Best of 05 Games except Midget Singles & Jumbled/Family Doubles which shall be Best of 03 Games.
- 08) The Tournament of any Singles OR Doubles Category will be combined, if less than 4 entries are received.
- 09) a) The Committee reserves the right to alter number of days, timings and other conditions of the Tournament.  
b) The Chief Referees & Committee's Decision shall be the final decision.
- 10) Program of play shall be strictly adhered to. Matches, once slated shall not be postponed except with the concurrence of the Committee. In the event of the competitor failing to show up within 15 minutes of the scheduled time, he/she shall be deemed to have given a walk over to his/her opponents. In the event of both the competitors failing to turn up, their names will be scratched from the Tournament.
- 11) No Spot/Dummy Entry will be accepted for any Event during the Tournament.
- 12) In the event of any dispute arising in the interpretation of the rules or during the match, the decision of the Referee & Committee shall be final and binding.
- 13) The Tournament Committee reserves the right of refusing any entry without assigning any reason.
- 14) Conditional Entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 15) All Participants are requested to bring their own GCH Identity Cards issued to them for verification at the time of submission of their Entry Forms without which the entries will not be accepted and must carry their Identity Cards during the Tournament, failing which they may not be allowed to take part in the Tournament.
- 16) For the Family Doubles Events both the participants must be Members & immediate relatives like Father & Son, Brother & Sister, Mother & Son, Husband & Wife...etc.
- 17) **Entries shall not be accepted after the cut-off date of Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2025 10:00 p.m.**
- 18) Use of Mobile Phone are strictly prohibited at the Tournament Venue.
